The Swiss/Argentinean label **Darek** presents its latest release, the **fourth part** of the acclaimed **Aleph Various Artists**. It's a collection of **ten tracks** from artists of all around the world (Germany, Cyprus, Russia, Mexico, Japan, Argentina, Italy, Denmark and France), selected with **a lot of attention** by the label managers.

This collection is **bringing together** artists separated by distance, but sharing the same passion. It's the result of a **stunning selection** going from **deep**, to **dark** and **experimental** sonorities. It's a subtle, rhythmic, **stylish**, intriguing and of course always **innovative compilation** of brand new and **exclusive compositions**.

It includes well known artists such as **Erich Bogatzky** (Minimood, Dieb Audio, Kina Music) and **Franklin De Costa** with his alter ego project **DCNT** (Einmaleins, Curle, Resopal, Sender) as well as **Signal Deluxe** (Trenton, Eintakt, Fade, Blaq) and many others like **Alex Tomb**, **Artemow**, **Iori Wakasa**, **Razz**, **Nico Cano**, **Nasty Boy** and **pFuzzle**.

"The Aleph and Other Stories (El Aleph, 1949) is a book of short stories by Argentine writer Jorge Luis Borges. The title work, "The Aleph", describes an artifact that can reveal the entire universe at once. The work also presents the idea of infinite time. Borges writes that most of the stories belong to the genre of fantasy, mentioning themes such as identity and immortality..."

Track by track:

1. Erich Bogatzky - Xenobia (Original Mix): We're thrilled to have Erich on board, and his Xenobia is the perfect way to start this various artists. It's a dreamy and deep tech house track, with a very nice atmosphere and some sweet beats. It's also ideal for the beginning or the middle of your set and it allows you to build a very effective ambience into the crowd.

2. Alex Tomb - Switch to MBP1 Board (Original Mix): Now, it's getting darker and a bit more twisted with the track of this Cypriot producer. It transports you in an electric place, with some melodies and a hypnotic bass. This is solid techno.

3. DCNT - Repeat on three (Original Mix): If you're looking for an intense composition, this will be right up your alley. It has a touch of acid sounds and some small breaks with the perfect dose of groove and mystic sonorities. That's what DCNT aka Franklin De Costa is offering you with this smashing production.

4. Artemow - Ladung (Original Mix): This track was made in Russia with a lot of love and positivity by Artemow, who's been releasing amazing productions for the past three years. It's deep and slower than the other ones that you experimented until now. It has a lot of emotion and is perfectly well constructed with key elements.

5. Signal Deluxe - Violets and roses (Original Mix): The Mexican duo presents their new composition. It's a track with an infectious groove and some melancholic vocals. It has a mixture of dark and pulsating intriguing sounds. This couple is creating some kick ass sounds and they have more than one trick up their sleeve.

6. Iori Wakasa - Love Is Organ (Original Mix): Now we're presenting you the new work of this young and talented Japanese producer from Tokyo. It's also the *housiest* production of this selection. In the second half of this diverse collection, especially with this track, we're offering you music with a lot of light and effective house vibes. Let's keep your eyes and ears wide open on this new bright star from Tokyo.

7. Razz - Andina (Original Mix): This Argentinean artist currently living in Mexico is offering you the perfect track for your warm up. It's a lineal and hypnotic production with the sexy laugh of a woman sampled and used flawlessly during this pleasant sound-trip. Razz has just released his new EP on the Mexico City based label Pantamuzik, and you'll hear much more from him in the future.

8. Nico Cano - Antique (Original Mix): We're presenting you another Argentinean with this pumping production. It has the right dose of tech house and some dub elements. It also has some old school influences. He's combining house, tech house and techno and a very subtle way.

9. Nasty Boy - Black Corner (Original Mix): This young Italian producer offers one of the deepest tracks of this journey. It also has some jazzy elements and a clear ambient touch. It's slowly announcing you the final of this trip into the most profound sonorities.

10. pFuzzle - Moelleux (Original Mix): With the composition of this French producer currently living in Denmark, we found the ideal track in order to close this adventure. It has groove and a lot of experimentation of high quality. We're offering you an opened final, leaving you enough space to expect the next Aleph...
